____ May 11 – **Petite Design**: A small design using fresh and/or dried plant material with design measuring 6 inches in height, width and depth.

____ June 8 – **Angular Design**: A creative design emphasizing strong angles that may be acute, obtuse, reflex, right angles or a combination of angles.

____ July 13 – **Grouped Mass Design**: A mass design of only plant material with radial placement. Like material is grouped and placed next to other different grouped material. Plant material emanates from one (1) point of emergence. Fresh plant material.

____ August 10 – **Multi-Rhythm Design**: A creative design with emphasis on two (2) or more rhythms in the design with one (1) rhythm dominating.

____ September 14 – **Lunch on the deck**: A functional tray for one to include a decorative unit in scale with the setting.

____ October 12 – **"Autumn in Maine" a Creative Design** using fresh and/or dried plant materials.
